CENTER FOR STUDENT PROGRESS

The Summer Bridge program and Bridge and Beyond program sponsored by the Center for Student Progress Multicultural Student Services has two components. First is Summer Bridge week where traditional-aged multicultural students participate in a full week of free residential, academic and social programming three weeks prior to fall semester. Summer Bridge activities are designed to assist students in their transition from high school to college. The week is full of both educational and social activities inside and outside the classroom such as meetings with financial aid, the Writing Center, and an off campus trip to area recreation centers. In addition, students experience team building activities in the Andrews Wellness Center, learn to set goals, manage their time, develop good study habits, and form bonds of friendships that, in most cases, last throughout their college experience.
