Requirements To Fulfill The Faculty-Led Travel Grant Contract

Study Abroad Scholarship Recipients are required to involve themselves in sharing their international experiences with the YSU community.

- Three mandatory requirements:
 - ◆ Attendance at pre-departure orientation
 - ◆ Successful completion of study abroad courses
 - ◆ Presentation of research report based on the completed study abroad at the YSU Quest student research conference (details at www.ysu.edu/quest) super

- You may choose at least one of the following tasks:
 - ◆ Write three articles about your study abroad experience for publication in YSU Update, Jambar, Vindicator, Etc.
 - ◆ Peer mentor an international student for one semester
 - ◆ Join International Student Organization and attend monthly meetings and other events throughout the semester
 - ◆ Attend weekly coffee hour from 2 – 4 pm in Jones Hall Lobby (TBA)
 - ◆ Three classroom presentations about study abroad experience
 - ◆ Assist with international orientation (Thursday and Friday prior to Fall Semester)
 - ◆ Assist with pre-departure orientation for study abroad students
 - ◆ Airport pick-up and drop off for a new international student (mileage will be reimbursed)
 - ◆ Invite international student to one or more social events
 - ◆ Invite an international student to a shopping trip (grocery or other)
 - ◆ Promote study abroad during study abroad fair (October 22, 2008 from 10:00 – 2:00 pm)
 - ◆ Promote study abroad at 2 SOAR sessions
 - ◆ Promote study abroad three times at information tables on campus
 - ◆ Volunteer in CISP office
 - ◆ Volunteer weekly conversation sessions for our English Language Institute Students
 - ◆ Other projects with Grant Committee Approval.
