



Becky Geltz of Poland is director of Institutional Research at Youngstown State University (YSU). A graduate of Poland Seminary High School, Geltz earned an associate degree in computer technology from YSU in 1991, a bachelor's degree in computer information systems graduating summa cum laude in 1993, and is currently pursuing a master of computing and information systems degree. She was originally hired as an IR analyst, was promoted to coordinator of the department and now is director. She is a recent recipient of a 2006 YSU Distinguished Service Award. Becky is a past president of the YSU Women's Club where she has been a member since academic year 1997-98, current president-elect and former vice president (2000 through 2008) of YSU's Chapter 143 of the Honor Society of Phi Kappa Phi, and has been a member since 1995 and served as treasurer 1998-2000 and vice president from 2000-2001 in the Ohio Association for Institutional Research and Planning (OAIRP). In addition Becky has been a member of the Northeast Association for Institutional Research since 2000 and was a member and served in various capacities at the national Association for Institutional Research forums from 1996 through 2007.
