\* The mean, or average, is calculated by summing the values from all reporting institutions and then dividing by the number of reporting institutions. The median value is the observation that is in the middle of the set or the value that divides the set in half where 50% of the values are equal to or greater than the median and 50% are less. The median becomes useful when examining a set containing extreme values that greatly affect the mean.

\*\* Rankings are from highest to lowest. For example, YSU's #11 ranking for Total Enrollment indicates that there are 10 other institutions with higher total enrollment within this peer group.
