

**POWER PLANT TECHNOLOGY**

**CHECKLIST**

The steps outlined below should be completed in the order shown, to ensure a smooth enrollment process.

- [ ] **Attend Powerplant Information Session.** Not required, but strongly advised. Check website at [www.yosu.edu/powersystems](http://www.yosu.edu/powersystems) for date and time of session.
  
- [ ] **Attend tour of Power plant.** Not required, but strongly advised. Details of the tour will be provided at the information session.
  
- [ ] **Apply for admission to Butler County Community College.**
  
- [ ] **Complete the required Math and English Placement Testing at BC3.** You must place into MATH 117 and ENGL 101 to be eligible to enroll in EUT 1502/L, Power Plant Fundamentals and Lab. This is the first YSU course in the program. If developmental coursework is required, you must complete these courses prior to admission to the program at YSU.
  
- [ ] **If you place into MATH 117 and ENGL 101, OR if you have completed developmental coursework, apply for admission to YSU.** This can be done on-line at [www.yosu.edu](http://www.yosu.edu). Indicate on the application that you are a TRANSFER student. Select Power Plant Technology as your major.
  
- [ ] **Have OFFICIAL High School and College Transcripts mailed directly to: Office of Admissions, Youngstown state University, Youngstown, OH 44555.**
  
- [ ] **The Office of Admission will provide you with information regarding advisement and registration for classes.**
  
- [ ] **When you receive verification from YSU Admissions regarding admission status, contact Dr. Bosela, Coordinator of the Powerplant Technology program at YSU, at 330-941-3286, or by email at [trbosela@ysu.edu](mailto:trbosela@ysu.edu).** Send copies of transcripts to the attention of Dr. Bosela via FAX at 330-941-2386 prior to contacting. Dr. Bosela will advise for coursework.
  
- [ ] **Contact the Financial Aid Office at BC3.** Inform them that you are enrolled in the joint BC3/YSU Power Plant Tech program. They will assist you with completing the “Ad-Hoc Consortium Agreement” form required to process financial aid.
