

Disability Parking

There are many handicapped parking places on campus but to access them you must have a YSU parking pass or pay a parking fee to park in university lots. State disability plates or hangtags are not sufficient for parking in handicapped spaces. Once a YSU parking permit is obtained, you must go to Parking Services, located in Smith Hall on Fifth Avenue across from Beeghly Hall, to obtain an accessibility sticker to affix to your current university permit. You must present your official handicap registration form in order to receive the accessibility sticker. If you do not have your original registration form, you may obtain a duplicate for a normal fee at any Bureau of Motor Vehicles Office. Eight week temporary disability parking is available with a written letter from a doctor.

Please be aware that any street parking is under the jurisdiction of the city and not the University. The only University metered parking is located in the visitor lot on University Plaza.
