Please note that mandated changes effective 2012 by the U.S. Department of Education have resulted in reclassification of employee classification

categories. For this reason, headcount figures beginning 2012 are not directly comparable to any prior year's figures.

SOC recoding project- Standard Occupational Classification (SOC) system is a federal statistical standard used by federal agencies to classify workers into occupational categories for the purpose of collecting, calculating, or disseminating data. It was necessary to review each position to ensure that positions were placed in the appropriate SOC codes and develop a consistent process going forward. By completing this project we can accurately and confidently report data to the state reporting agencies.

Headcount- the reduction is based on the changing business and service needs that occurred due to the Coronavirus pandemic.

Postsecondary Teachers: Report all persons whose specific assignments customarily are made for the purpose of providing instruction or

teaching, conducting research, or carrying out public services activities, regardless of title, academic rank, or tenure status.
