First Serve

The Youngstown State volleyball team (12-17, 5-11 Horizon League) earned the seventh seed in the upcoming Horizon League Championship and will take on No. 2 seed Cleveland State, Friday, Nov. 16, at 3 p.m. EDT.

This will be the third time this season and the second time in less than a week the Penguins and Vikings have squared off.

This will be the 49th meeting between Youngstown State and Cleveland State. The Vikings own a 37-11 advantage in the all-time series, including a sweep of the season series this year. The Vikings defeated the Guins, 3-1, in both matches.

The YSU/CSU winner will take on the winner of No. 3 Wright State/No. 6 UIC on Saturday, Nov. 17, at 2:30 p.m. EDT.

About Cleveland State

Cleveland State earned the No. 2 seed in the Horizon League Championship after posting a 12-3 Horizon League record. Overall the Vikings finished 20-8.

The Vikings landed three players on the 2007 Horizon League All-League Team - Amy Benz, Beth Greulich and Mel Snyder.

Benz, the 2007 Horizon League Newcomer of the Year, led the League with 1.54 blocks per game and a .336 hitting percentage and recorded 2.26 kills per game.

Greulich posted 3.08 kills per game and a .310 hitting percentage, which ranked third in the league, while Snyder dished out a league-leading 1,289 assists and 11.83 assists per game.

Fraley Nets League Honors

Senior Jessica Fraley became the second player in school history to garner All-Horizon League honors. Last season, Ruth Boscaljon was named co-newcomer of the year and all-league. Fraley's 411 kills are the third-highest in the league and her 3.45 kills per game ranks sixth.

Guins Set Wins Mark

With five wins during the 2007 Horizon League campaign, Youngstown State set a school mark for most league wins since joining the circuit in 2001. Youngstown State's 12 overall wins are the most since the 2000 season when the Penguins won 14 in their last season in the Mid-Continent Conference.

Shives Can Dig It

Freshman defensive specialist/libero Laurie Shives has been one of the best back-row players in the Horizon League in 2007. Shives ranks ninth in the league with 3.78 digs per game. Her 431 digs is tied for third on the YSU single-season list and is the most digs by a YSU player in the rally-scoring era. She also needs 18 more to set the YSU single-season digs record.

Boscaljon Joins 700-Club

Sophomore Ruth Boscaljon is skyrocketing her way towards the 1,000 career kills plateau. The Elgin, Ill., native has already amassed 717 kills in just 61 matches and 230 games. She owns a 3.12 kill per game career average and needs just 283 more kills to reach 1,000.

Fraley Climbing Kills Charts

Senior Jessica Fraley moved into fifth place on the YSU single-season kills list with 411 kills and needs 12 more to move into fourth place. She is just the fifth player in school history to post 400 kills in a season. Fraley also needs 15 more kills to become the ninth player in school history to record 1,000 career kills and ranks ninth with 985.

Barbosa Joins Exclusive Club

Junior Ebony Barbosa is just the eighth player in school history to record at least 300 kills and 300 digs in the same season with 317 kills and 392 digs. Her 392 digs also rank eighth on the YSU single-season digs chart.

Everhart's Career Year

Junior setter Karla Everhart is having the best year of her career. The native of Elyria, Ohio, has tallied a career-best 1,180 assists for an average of 10.35 assists per game, which ranks fifth in the Horizon League. Her total number of assists is the second-highest in the Horizon League.

Heinz in Top 10

Sophomore middle hitter Allison Heinz has been quite efficient this season. Heinz, who has 195 kills, ranks fourth in the Horizon League with a .307 hitting percentage against Horizon League foes. Overall, Heinz is 10th in the league with a .259 hitting percentage.

Fraley Nabs Academic Honors

Senior right side hitter Jessica Fraley was named to the College Sports Information Director's (CoSIDA) Academic All-District Third-Team, the organization announced on Nov. 8.

Fraley, who owns a 3.87 grade-point average in telecommunications, is just the third YSU volleyball player to earn academic all-district honors. Abby Ettenhofer (2005) and Kristen Meech (2000 and 2001) are the only two other players to accomplish this feat.

Everhart Continues to Climb

With 1,180 assists this season, junior Karla Everhart moved into fifth place on the single-season assists list. She also ranks fifth all-time with 2,362 career assists. She is also just the third player in school history to post consecutive 1,000 assists seasons.

Season Outlook

It happens every year. College coaches reflect upon the lessons learned - both good and bad - from the previous season in an effort to ascertain what it will take to make the next step in building a championship contender.

For Youngstown State and Head Coach Joe Bonner, 2006's three-win improvement from the year before while often using several freshman and two inexperienced sopho-

mores is a move in the right direction. But now, expectations continue to rise.

A significant challenge to the Penguins' rise in the Horizon League will be the relative youth of the 2007 roster. Of the 13 players on the team, 10 are sophomores and freshmen with only one senior and two juniors.

Seven players, however, have at least a year of college playing experience and the entire squad's versatility and depth are two keys factors Bonner believes will bring the Penguins success.

Setter

Returning to run the offense for the second straight season is junior setter Karla Everhart.

Everhart, who already ranks seventh all-time with 1,182 career assists, dished out 1,125 assists and averaged 10.32 assists per game during her sophomore season.

Suffering from a foot injury, Everhart did not compete in the spring but still displayed true leadership characteristics.

Freshman Dani Soubliere, an all-state performer from Howell, Mich., is expected to get playing time as Everhart's backup.

Outside Hitter

Probably the most athletic and the area with the most depth is at the outside hitter

In two short seasons, Youngstown State Volleyball Head Coach Joe Bonner has already put his stamp on the Penguins volleyball program.

Bonner, who is entering his third season, continually dedicates his energies to turning the Penguins into one of the top teams in the Horizon League and the region.

In May 2006, his recruiting class ranked in the top 100 by prepvolleyball.com.

One of those recruits, Ruth Boscaljon, became the first Youngstown State volleyball player to earn First-Team All-Horizon League and just the second player in school history to garner the newcomer-of-the-year award.

Utilizing three freshmen and two limited-experienced sophomores for much of the 2006 season, the Penguins turned in a three-match improvement in the win column from Bonner's first year.

Boscaljon set a Youngstown State freshman record with 363 kills and 115 blocks while sophomore setter Karla Everhart dished out 1,125 assists.

During his initial campaign, Bonner guided the Penguins through an injury-plagued 7-22 season, but he instilled a strong competitive desire. Included in the Penguins' losses were five five-game setbacks, all to Horizon League foes.

Abby Ettenhofer, Katie Shea and Crystal Duncan each capped their playing days with career-best numbers. Ettenhofer led the team with 334 kills while Shea owned a team-best 106 blocks and Duncan added 173 kills and 153 digs.

Bonner's players also made strides off the court. Ettenhofer, the president of YSU's Student-Athlete Advisory Committee, was named Second-Team Academic All-America, becoming just the second YSU volleyball player to accomplish that feat.

Bonner was named the seventh head coach of the Youngstown State volleyball program on Feb. 4, 2005, after spending two seasons as the top assistant coach at the University of Dayton.

Bonner helped the Flyers to a two-year mark of 49-16, including a 23-9 overall ledger in 2004, and two straight trips to the NCAA Tournament.

In 2004, the Flyers also won their second straight Atlantic-10 regular-season championship with a 12-2 conference mark. While at Dayton, Bonner worked primarily with the middle hitters and blockers. In addition to his on-court duties, he was responsible for team travel, game operations and assisting with recruiting.

Prior to Dayton, Bonner, who has been to five NCAA Tournaments, spent three seasons as an assistant coach at Robert Morris (2000-2002) and helped the Colonials to three consecutive Northeast Conference titles and three straight NCAA Tournaments.

While at Robert Morris, Bonner was responsible for the development of the middle hitters. Under his guidance, four middle hitters received all-conference honors and one earned NEC Player-of-the-Year accolades for two consecutive years.

He also was the travel and recruiting coordinator and served as the team's strength and conditioning coach.

Outside of the college realm, Bonner also has four years of collegiate club volleyball coaching experience.

A 1997 graduate of Frostburg State University, Bonner's club team made two national tournament appearances, as well as three years of USAV competition.

A native of Huntingtown, Md., Bonner received a Bachelor of Science degree in Economics from Frostburg State.

Joe and his wife, Kelly, who was a four-year volleyball letterwinner at Mars Hills College, reside in Austintown, Ohio.

position.

Only two of the five outside hitters listed on the roster have college experience at that spot but Bonner has a tremendous amount of confidence in those players.

Junior Ebony Barbosa is the most experienced of the outside hitters with 409 career kills, including 299 last season as a sophomore.

Sophomore Dana Leslie, who tallied 10 kills and appeared in 15 matches last season mostly during the later stages of the campaign, showed a lot of improvement during the spring season and is poised to contribute on the left side.

Sophomore Kaitlin O'Hara is one of three new faces on the left side for Bonner. The 6-foot-2 native of Canandaigua, N.Y., is making the transition to outside hitter from middle hitter where she recorded 197 kills and 69 blocks while missing a month due to a shoulder injury.

Freshmen Kesli Bitter and Abigail Drost, who enrolled in school in January, round out the left-side hitters.

Middle Hitters

The position which achieved the most success last season and one of the most veteran on the team is in the middle.

Sophomores Ruth Boscaljon and Allison Heinz combined for 454 kills and 203 blocks as freshmen last season.

Boscaljon also was named to the All-Horizon League First-Team and captured Co-Newcomer of the Year in 2006 after boasting a YSU freshmen record 363 kills and 128 blocks. Meanwhile, Heinz nailed 191 kills and 75 total blocks last season.

Newcomer Haley Kapferer, a 2006 Wendy's High School Heisman candidate, could also see time in the middle.

As a senior at Jefferson Area High School, Kapferer notched 271 kills and 86 blocks and was named the conference player of the year.

Right Side Hitters

Three-year letterwinner and the lone senior on the club Jessica Fraley returns for her final season on the right side.

A 2004 Horizon League All-Newcomer Team pick, Fraley has been hampered by two abdominal surgeries over the last two seasons but is back healthy.

During her freshman campaign, Fraley collected 360 kills and 270 digs but has appeared in just 28 matches over the last two seasons due to injury.

Freshman Tasha Reid from Avonmore, Pa., is also slated to see action on the right side.

Tasha is a strong blocker and versatile player that needs some seasoning," Bonner said. "She's has a tremendous upside."

Defensive Specialists/Libero

The Penguins will have to recoup their biggest losses from last season's back row lineup. Replacing last year's defensive specialists/liberos Amanda Cindric, Cari Leslie and Janelle McDonald, who compiled a combined 3,261 career digs, may be Bonner's toughest task this season and begins with newcomer Laurie Shives.

Shives, a *Columbus Dispatch* "20 Area High School Volleyball Players to Watch" selection, was named her team's best defensive player and collected 347 digs during her senior season at Central Crossing High School.
