**Policy:** Youngstown State University is a smoke-free environment. Smoking is not permitted in any buildings and vehicles, except in designated areas.

RESOLUTION NUMBERS: YR 1997-49; YR 2007-23

**Purpose:** The smoke-free environment procedures are designed to create and maintain an environmental quality which sustains the general health and well-being of students, faculty, staff and visitors, and also to comply with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3794.01 through 3794.09.

#### **Procedures:**

1. Permanent signage is posted throughout the campus designating smoke-free areas.
2. Smoking in a designated smoke-free area may be cause for an individual student, faculty, or staff member to be subject to an applicable disciplinary procedure.
3. Individuals smoking in a smoke-free area should be informed of their violation of University Policy and state law.
4. Smoking violations may be reported to the appropriate designated authority.
